2008-2009 NCRHA Team Registration Packet

All materials are to be submitted to your Member Organization. Unless otherwise noted, all materials must be received by your Member Organization by October 15th, 2008 or 72 hours before your team's first game.

Please use the enclosed Team Checklist to ensure that all registration materials have been completed. Your specific Member Organization may have additional registration materials that must be completed before league play can commence. Please consult your league director for details.

If at any time you have any questions or concerns, do not hesitate to contact the league using the information provided in this document.

New documentation will soon be released for 2008-2009, including an updated League Operations Manual. They will be posted online in the NCRHA Document Center at www.ncrha.org.

ITEMS OF NOTE FOR THE 2008-2009 SEASON

1. New Divisional Structure

All previous divisional restrictions based on enrollment have been removed (ie. the "18,000 rule). This allows all four-year schools to determine which division they wish to play in. Each Division carries with it a series of requirements and benefits, some requiring greater commitment in both time and finances. For more information, see the following pages where the Divisional Requirements are detailed.

2. NCRHA Winterfest

The NCRHA will once again bring you Winterfest, held in Key West, Florida in early January. We are working towards securing the dates for the next 2 years. This is an open-invitation tournament to all NCRHA Active Members. More details to come at www.ncrha.org. The dates will be posted online as soon as they are available.

3. NCRHA National Championships

The NCRHA is working towards securing sites and dates for the next 2 National Championship Tournaments. These things take time, so we are asking for your patience.

4. Increased NCRHA Marketing/PR

The NCRHA was represented at both Narch Finals and State Wars for the past 2 years. Nanette Houser, NCRHA Director of Marketing, was in attendance with the NCRHA College Information Station. The NCRHA realizes that youth are the future of our sport, and that our presence at these large events is crucial to our overall longevity. We are also "doing our part" to keep interest alive in the sport of roller hockey. We are there to show these young players that they can continue playing all the way through high school and into college.

The NCRHA is working with one of their sponsors, Mission Hockey, to bring you a Mission Hockey College at an event in your area. Hockey College is a clinic for the youth of the area to come out and skate with college roller hockey players and be mentored on improving skills, etc. Your Member Organization Director will be contacted in order to get you involved in helping out with this event.

4. Payments

- All payments are to be submitted to your Member Organization. They will be invoicing you for both your Regular Season and for your NCRHA Registration Fees. No payments are necessary to the NCRHA, except for the NCRHA Winterfest and National Championships.
- National Championships Fees – All fees paid for entrance to the National Championships (or Winter Invitational) will be subject to the following refund criteria: 50% refund with 2 weeks notification; No refund with less than 2 weeks notification; Alternates fully refundable unless they accept a spot from a dropped team.
- The NCRHA continues its policy of not accepting personal checks. The NCRHA will be collecting a \$25 fee for all NSF (insufficient funds) checks.

To all players, staff, parents, alumni,

Welcome to another exciting season of collegiate roller hockey. 2008-2009 marks the 14th year that a collegiate roller hockey champion has been crowned, and the 11th year that a national governing body for collegiate roller hockey has officially sanctioned the sport and held a “True National Championship.”

We had a great National Championship Tournament in Colorado Springs, Colorado last April. 60 teams from across the nation again competed to be crowned champion in 4 divisions. The event was held at 2 locations, the Tour Inline Hockey Arena and the Colorado Sports Center. Thank you goes out to all of the teams that competed and helped make this event a success, and one of our best yet!

Once again, you will be asked to submit your registration paperwork no later than October 15th or 72 hours before your first game of the season, whichever occurs first. All completed registration materials are to be mailed or handed to your Member Organization Director, not to the NCRHA office.

If you look at the checklist provided on the following pages, you will have a comprehensive listing of everything you need to do to prepare for the upcoming season. Due dates for paperwork are included where applicable. Do not hesitate to submit anything you have completed before the due date – we appreciate having completed materials early. Your Member Organization may have several documents in addition to this packet that are required in order to register.

A Letter of Recognition of the team as an official student organization is to be submitted by the due date on the checklist. An administrator at your school must complete this and sign with their information. Additionally, forms have been provided to verify that all players on your team are taking the requisite number of credits at your school. Please note that these forms must be completed for ALL players on the roster. They must be signed and/or stamped by your registrar to be accepted.

Please, use the web site tools that have been provided for you! I am always surprised at the number of high school players who write NCRHA and already know everything about the roller hockey teams at the schools they are considering. Make sure your information on the website is updated and post articles regularly. Additionally, use the PPS Administration Area to check on the status of your registration paperwork. A short summary on using PPS is provided in this packet.

Lastly, our divisional changes should make for an exciting season! No longer are teams placed into a division based solely on their school size. The teams themselves have chosen where to participate, based on a number of criteria. Overall, the NCRHA believes that this will be good for the sport!

Finally, good luck to all teams in the upcoming 2008-2009 season. See you on the rink!

NCRHA.org and PowerPlayStats.com

Once again, the NCRHA has contracted with PowerPlayStats™ (PPS) to bring you updated standings, stats and scores. Below is a brief summary of the areas online that you will need to keep up-to-date this year, as well as instructions on how to do so.

Logging In

Go to your member organization site or NCRHA.org and click on the PPS icon. Click on “Admin Login” at the bottom of the page. You will be brought to the PPS login page. Your login is tied to your email address. Enter your email address and password (same as last year). If you have forgotten your password, you can have a new one sent to you by clicking the “Forgot Password” link immediately below the login box. If you are a brand new team or don’t know if you have an email address set up, contact PPS at support@powerplaystats.com or your Member Organization Director for your login information.

Changing Your Password

Chances are good that you’ll never remember the password that was created for you. After logging in, click on the “My Account” section on the top right and update your password through the “Change Password” button.

League and Content Menus

The main two pull-down menus to be concerned with are League and Content. Those will lead you to adding players to your roster, posting news articles about your team, etc. Please feel free to explore all of the drop-down menus as soon as possible, to ease your familiarity with the site. NCRHA Divisional Requirements

Division I

- a) The primary teams of all four-year universities and colleges (previously those eligible for Division I and Division II) shall be eligible to play in Division I, provided they are willing and able to comply with the requirements to participate in the division.
- b) It is to be noted that high-caliber talent is not a prerequisite to play Division I; rather, Division I is intended for the most organized and committed member clubs.
- c) Requirements
 - i. Full matching home and away jerseys.
 - ii. Full matching pants. This includes both style and manufacturer.
 - iii. All players (with the exception of the goaltender) must wear matching color helmets.
 - iv. Effective January 1, 2009, all teams must have a registered coach behind the bench for all games.
 - v. Effective September 1, 2009, all registered coaches must have completed a minimum of Level 1 USA Hockey coaching certification.
 - vi. Effective September 1, 2009, all players must have gloves that match the color scheme of their uniform or black gloves. All gloves need not be the same manufacturer or style.
 - vii. Cross-regional play is not required, but strongly encouraged.
- d) Following the start of the season, any team found in violation of the requirements above shall risk forfeiture of postseason play (Regional and National Championships).
- e) Benefits
 - i. Opportunity for more games during the regular season than Division II teams (consult your Member Organization Director for regional specifics)
 - ii. Expanded number of bids to the Collegiate Roller Hockey National Championships. The field has been expanded to 24 teams for 2008-2009.
 - iii. First-priority scheduling for both event weekends and game times during weekend events. All efforts will be made to accommodate scheduling requests from Division I teams as well as schedule games during "prime-time". (consult your Member Organization Director)
 - iv. Ability to organize and play sanctioned "home and home" NCRHA games at a facility independent of NCRHA weekend events.
 - v. First priority to invitations to interregional events and other special NCRHA events.
 - vi. Increased exposure to marketing and promotion by the NCRHA

Division II

- a) As a result of the removal of enrollment restrictions, any primary team from a four-year college or university may participate in Division II.
- b) Requirements
 - i. Full matching home and away jerseys.
 - ii. Pants of the same predominant color.
 - iii. A coach is strongly recommended, but not required.
- c) Following the start of the season, any team found in violation of the requirements above shall risk forfeiture of postseason play (Regional and National Championships).
- d) Benefits
 - i. Opportunity for more games during the regular season than Division III teams.
 - ii. 16 bids to the Collegiate Roller Hockey National Championships.

NCRHA Divisional Requirements (cont.)

Division III

- a) Redefined. Division III will no longer include the primary teams of two-year, community or junior colleges, but will instead be targeted towards new and developing teams.
- b) Requirements
- c) One set of fully matching jerseys (check colors with your Member Organization Director before jersey design/production/purchase)
- d) Features
 - i. Shorter season requiring less financial and time commitment.
 - ii. No national championship tournament will be held in this division.

Junior College Division

- a) Formerly titled Division III, this division has been renamed to eliminate confusion.
- b) The Junior College (JC) Division is restricted to primary teams of two-year, community and junior colleges.
- c) Requirements
 - i. Full matching home and away jerseys.
 - ii. Pants of the same predominant color.
 - iii. A coach is strongly recommended, but not required.
- d) Following the start of the season, any team found in violation of the requirements above shall risk forfeiture of postseason play (Regional and National Championships).
- e) Benefits
 - i. 8 bids to the Collegiate Roller Hockey National Championships.

B Division

- a) Reserved for secondary teams of schools in all other divisions
- b) Requirements
 - i. Full matching home and away jerseys.
 - ii. Pants of the same predominant color.
 - iii. A coach is strongly recommended, but not required.
- c) Following the start of the season, any team found in violation of the requirements above shall risk forfeiture of postseason play (Regional and National Championships).
- d) Benefits
 - i. 12 bids to the Collegiate Roller Hockey National Championships.

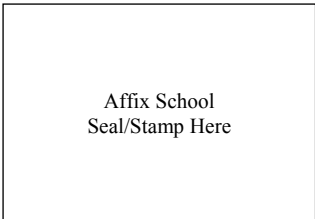
